YOUR NAME ON THE WALL

Organizations making contributions of \$1,000 or more will be recognized on a wall of donors/partners that will be featured on the main/event floor of the new building. This will be easily visible from the main entrance and will appear between the two doors of the board/conference room.

Organizations making contributions of \$5,000 or more will be recognized more prominently on the wall. Additional levels may be added based on response.

Here is a preliminary rendering of how this will appear:



NAME A ROOM

The new building will have an event center, holding up to 60 people, which MREA will use for many of our events. It also has a board/conference room on the main level and a conference room on the second level. The organizations making the top three donations will be recognized on the wall (above) and will also have the opportunity to name one of these three rooms. The top donor chooses their room and name first, followed by the second largest donor. This will be based on donations as of Jan. 15, 2026, and any ties will be settled through a random draw.
